- No cell service in most of the school district


State of Technology Fall 2010

- No cell service within 7 miles of the schools
- Wireless internet via small office access points
- 8 to 10 year old network hardware
- 6 laptop carts for the school district
- 30 to 50 unauthorized student devices on the network daily
- Filtering done by a third party (Intermediate Unit)

- Fall 2010 donation of \$40,000
- Invitation to Watkins Glen, NY


Best Practices
