School Nurse Protocol and Standing Orders Policy  
Agreement  
November 17, 2009

North Penn Comprehensive Health Services proposes to provide the additional requested services through the Laurel Health System Occupational Health program, a service of the Community Support Services. The Occupational Health Physician and Medical Director will approve standing orders for first aid treatment and dispensing of over the counter medications. The Occupational Health Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner (CRNP) under the supervision of the Medical Director may be consulted for Physical Therapy/Occupational Therapy evaluation and referral, and the approval of the Protocol Manual at the hourly rate of \$50.00, not to exceed a total of 12 hours per annum, expiring June 30, 2010.

1. Reviewing / approving / recommending school nurse protocols
2. Reviewing / approving / recommending standing order protocols
3. Reviewing forms and approving forms for medical information purposes only.



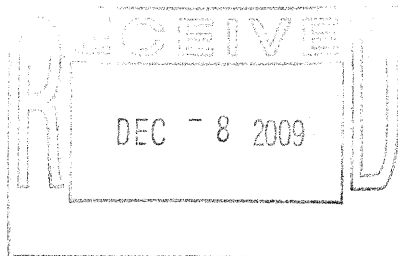

The Pennsylvania Department of Education is pleased to announce that the 2009-10 Pennsylvania Education budget includes funding for Cohorts two and three Classrooms for the Future/ 21<sup>st</sup> Century Teaching and Learning technology integration coaches for the amount of \$25,000. These coaches may support teachers utilizing technology for teaching and learning in grades 5-12 in any subject area.

Coach salaries can be charged to this funding as of July 1, 2009. All coaches should be hired and in place for the second semester. There will be a coaching meeting planned for the second semester for new coaches.
