The **PURPOSE** of this independent study is to provide students with an opportunity to study an academic area which they hope to further pursue in college. This course will be an "upper level" course that goes beyond the basic content of Sociology and Film & Society. The course will also strive to prepare the student for successful study of related courses at the college level.

Some of the **TOPICS** covered in this course will include an overview of the major social institutions - family, economy, government, sports, education - as well as other sociological topics such as culture, deviance/crime, and socialization.

Under most circumstances, the independent study participants may provide input regarding the topics covered in the course, which allows the opportunity to cover information that particularly interests them.

ASSESSMENT will be accomplished through both written and oral evaluations, written assignments, and hands-on/real world assignments. Students will be required to complete reading responses, case study analyses, video responses, research summaries, and a final research paper.

Students who do not attend scheduled meetings, do not complete assignments, or if they demonstrate a poor attitude or a lack of effort, they will lose points and may also lose the privilege of having an independent study.

Students who successfully complete this independent study will receive .5 Social Studies **CREDIT** (semester course).




