Report from Superintendent

Superintendent Morral introduced Pat Hewitt, Federal Programs Coordinator/Director of Curriculum and Instruction. Pat presented to the Board a PowerPoint presentation on 2014-15 WASD PSSA/Keystone Results.

Superintendent Morral also introduced Bryan Murphy, Computer Technician/Network Administrator who addressed the Board regarding the 1:1 Project. Superintendent Morral thanked the maintenance department for all the work they have done. He also congratulated Mr. Pietropola and the Middle School faculty and staff for being recognized with the District IV Sportsmanship Award.

Report from Business Manager

Business Manager Bonnie Thompson reported to the Board that the first RFP was awarded to Citizens & Northern Bank for the refinance of the 2010 AAA Bond. As of August 10, the second RFP is awarded to First Citizens Bank for the refinance of the 2010 Bond, 2010A Bond and a portion of the 2010AA. Due to these two steps in the refinance process, there is a savings of \$1.9 million on the projections that Les Bear of Robert W. Baird presented to the Board. She also reported to the Board that the auditors were here at the end of June 2015 and will be back in September 2015.

Report from Administrators

Steve Adams, Elementary Principal, reported that safety tours have been conducted and completed both at the Charlotte Lapla and Don Gill Elementary School.

Mike Pietropola, Middle School Principal, reported that the Middle School went through a Risk and Vulnerability Assessment. He thanked the coaches and athletes for their great sportsmanship and congratulated them for winning the District 4 Sportsmanship Award. He also thanked Daren Bryant, Director of Buildings & Grounds and all of the maintenance and custodial staff for all of their hard work.

Pat Hewitt, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, reported to the Board that the District had 60 teachers attend the various Boot Camp events throughout the summer.

David Krick, High School Principal, reported Ben Miller, HS Social Studies teacher, was invited by College Boards to travel to Salt lake City, Utah this summer where he served as an AP Reader for the US Government and Politics AP Exam. Mr. Krick also reported that we had a student score a "5" on the AP Government exam this year. Only 9.8% nationally score a "5". Mrs. Tiffany Getty participated in an AP Chemistry Institute this summer preparing to offer AP Chemistry in the 2016-17 school year. Student council is in full swing and Ms. Niver is excited about this year's group of students and their level of enthusiasm. The Perkins Grant for the CTE programs should be submitted very soon. Plans for the laptop distribution will take place on August 20 from 10:00 – 3:30 PM and on August 25 from 4:00 – 9:00 PM for Grades 9 and 10. August 21 from 10:00 – 3:30 PM and August 24 from 4:00 – 9:00 PM for 11 and 12 grades. Open House and New Student Orientation will be held on August 25 from 7:00-9:00 PM.
