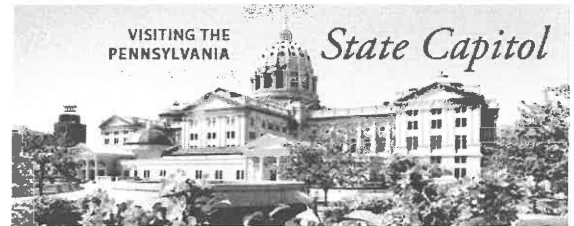
3:00 Walk over to the Capitol and go through security.
