Dear Mrs. Huck:

North Penn Comprehensive Health Services d/b/a/ Laurel Health Centers is proposing this quote to the Wellsboro Area School District for health care provider services to perform sports and classroom physicals for the 2022-2023 School Year. The Laurel Health Centers is pleased to offer the service at a price of \$83.00 per hour. Our estimate approximates we will see 12-14 children per hour.

The Laurel Health Center Providers, Nurse Practitioners and Physician Assistants, will conduct the Grade Level Physicals as required by Section 1402 of the Pennsylvania Public School Code to students in the Wellsboro Area School District.

The general health physical examination will include the following. No internal examinations are to be performed.

- General Appearance/Posture/Gait Behavior during Examination
- Ears – External/Canals/Tympanic Membranes
- Eyes – Externals
- Nose/Mouth/Pharynx
- Teeth (use dental chart)
- Heart
- Lungs
- Abdomen
- Genitalia
- Bones/Joints/Muscles
- Neurological Examination
- Pulse
- Blood Pressure
- Vision & Hearing Screening
- Height/Weight

The School Nurse will be present during the physical examination and – will assist with the following: Blood Pressure, Pulse, Height & Weight, and Vision & Hearing screening.

The Laurel Health Center Providers - will conduct Athletic physicals for students participating in P.I.A.A. sports at the Wellsboro Area School District schools and as requested by the District, at the same rate.

The physical examination shall include an examination to determine the students' general physical condition and whether student is physically fit to participate in athletic contests in the sport(s) and during the sports season(s) as indicated on the PIAA Physician's Certificate, as noted in sections 4,5, and 6 in the PIAA Comprehensive Initial Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation form. Each athlete requires a physical before he/she may participate recertification unless an injury has been sustained since the last examination.

As stated, physicals would be arranged at the convenience of both the schools and the health care provider. It is our expectation that the respective school nurses will provide assistance at the various clinics to facilitate the overall process. To schedule these services listed above, please contact the Laurel Health Centers at 570-662-1948.

A review of the Wellsboro Area School District Protocol Manual for Standing orders will be included. **However, the Laurel Health Centers cannot provide Standing Orders for Over-the Counter (OTC) medications and cannot provide Vaccination Prescriptions and Administration.** These activities should be completed for students by their Primary Care Provider and are not included as part of our services.

Additionally, as part of our efforts to promote healthy children and health communities, we will provide information to children and parents regarding choices for their continued health care at the Laurel Health Center in their community. We believe a positive connection between the School District and the Community Health Center promotes healthy choices and alternatives for the students and their families. The Laurel Health Centers may provide educational materials for distribution. The Wellsboro Area School District will include these materials in their mailings to parents and guardians of the students scheduled for physicals.
