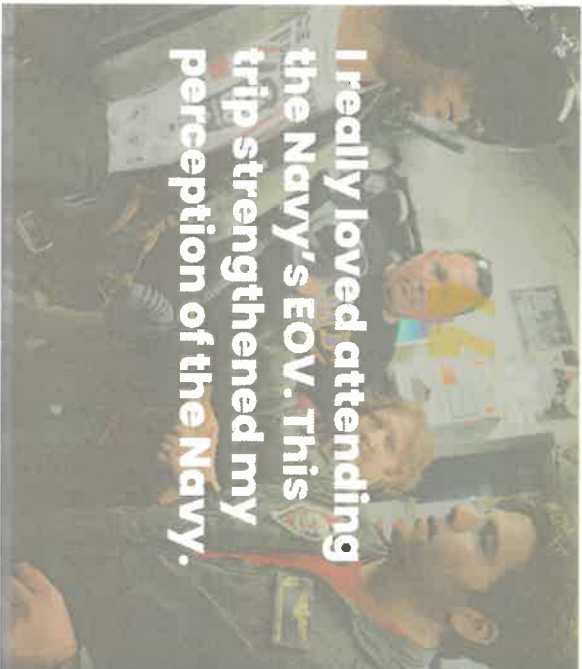

EOV participants may include state and local school district superintendents, administrators, school board presidents, college and university presidents, deans, department heads, professors, high school principals, teachers, counselors, career specialists, college placement officials, coaches, youth group leaders, or other individuals on a case-by-case basis who have direct association with the student and workforce markets.

Participants are nominated by their local recruiters and ultimately selected by the commanding officers of their recruiting command. These nominees play a vital role in helping recruiters build a relationship with their local communities, schools and students.
