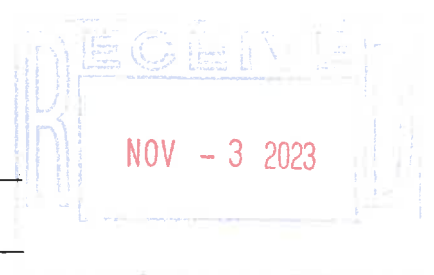

Hello all!

The past few weeks have been very busy in the culinary classroom. We had multiple students compete in the Skills USA competition at Penn Tech College in Williamsport, and two of our culinary students are currently preparing for the state level Skills competition in Hershey in the middle of April. We are also busy running Java Hive and organizing teacher luncheons. With all of these events going on, your students are also preparing for the *Cook Around the World* Competition in Disney at the end of April.

We now have the itinerary and competition information from Disney and the travel company. I did share this in class with your student but wanted to send it home to all of you as well. I am not sure if they have shared with you yet. This year, the students don't find out their continent until they arrive at Disney for the competition. This is new this year and will be very exciting! It will really test the students' creativity and cooking skills! I am excited to see what they come up with.

Your student should have shared with you their total contribution for the flight/trip (this has been on the board at school for a while!) is \$400, due January 31, 2024. This helps cover the cost of the flight. In addition to this cost, your student will need to bring money to cover the cost of their meals and any souvenirs they choose to purchase. A rough estimate for food cost daily is \$45 (\$10 for breakfast, \$15 for lunch, \$20 for dinner). Students are able to bring snacks in their bags if they choose. That money will go directly with your student when we depart, that does not come to the school! In previous years, students have brought cash, debit cards, or even Disney gift card as forms of payment.

The information below should hopefully answer any questions that you have regarding the trip. Please feel free to reach out to me at any time if you have any questions or concerns, I have not addressed below.

Trip Dates: April 24-May 1st

Students will depart Wellsboro High School at 3:30pm on Wednesday, April 24th. The flight departs Elmira Regional Airport at 6:39pm. I have included the flight and hotel information below for you as well.

Documents:

Your student will need to have identification for the airplane. If they have a driver's license or passport, please have them bring that as their form of identification. For any student who does not have a driver's license or passport, please send their birth certificate.

- Once we land, all luggage will be collected at baggage claim and we will head back to Wellsboro. Estimated time of arrival in Wellsboro is 7:15 pm. Students will be excused from school that day and are allowed go home upon return to Wellsboro. A permission slip will be sent home before the trip for you to indicate if your student may be released or expected to go to school that day to avoid any confusion upon returning.
- All students should be picked up from the high school upon arrival in the upper parking lot by the administration building (or students who drive may leave their cars at school in the parking lot and may drive home upon arrival with parent permission).

Chaperones:

Both Mrs. Mack and I will be the chaperones for the trip. We are taking 10 students in total. As we get closer to departure, we will set up a group in the *Life 360 app* which allow each member of the group to see the location of all individuals. This helps keep track of the students at all times. The entire group travels to the park together each day. We break into group (or stay as a whole) depending on the day and what the group would like to ride/see. We set multiple meet times throughout the day at specific locations within the park to check in. All students will also have both mine and Mrs. Mack's cellphone numbers as well as each other's numbers so that we have multiple ways to stay in touch. I will include our numbers here for you as well. We will meet in the evening to travel back on the bus together to the resort as a group. The students are "free" to ride rides in groups but are not allowed to leave the specified park at any time.

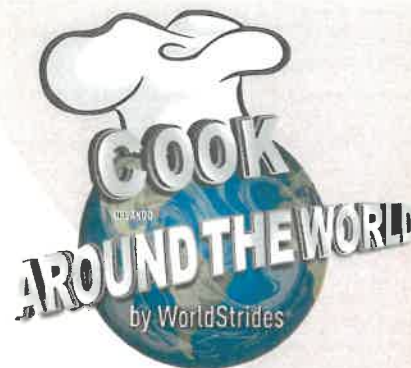
As we get closer to the trip date, we will be having a meeting with both parents and students about the trip at school to answer any last-minute questions and share any final information we get.
